Chair Boggess called the meeting to order. Mrs. Boggess asked if there were any additions to the agenda. There being no additions, the public hearing was conducted.

Chair Boggess stated that the purpose of this meeting was to conduct a public hearing with VDOT officials to receive public comment on the Revised Six Year Plan for Bedford County Secondary System Improvements and the 2002-2007 Priority Listing for improvements.
