(5) Dr. Blevins reported that the Construction Committees of the Board of Supervisors and School Board had met for three days interviewing six (6) architectural firms which responded to the Request for Proposal for Architectural and Engineering Services for Design and Construction of High School Space. He stated that the committee recommended going with Hayes, Seay, Mattern & Mattern, Inc. for this project.

(6) John Owen, IMEC Engineers, appeared to give an update on the remediation work which they have been performing at Jefferson Forest High School in light of the recent mold which was found. He reported that the scope of work is complete and the mold growth has been eliminated and the work was performed 10% under budget.

School Board member Earle wanted to congratulate IMEC Engineers for the nice job they performed at the school.

(7) Gary Davis, Director of Personnel, gave an update on teacher salaries. He stated the teacher supply is declining. He said 100 new teachers were hired for the upcoming school year which was down from 130 last year. He provided an informational presentation which included charts comparing teacher salaries in Bedford County to other localities.

(8) Bobbi Johnson, Director of Instruction, gave an Instructional update presentation which included charts by grade and subject for the past few years showing the passing percentages for all the SOL testing.
