Voter Photo Identification

Effective July 1, 2014, Virginia law changed to require all in-person voters to present acceptable photo identification. Acceptable forms of identification include the following:

- Valid Virginia Driver's License
- DMV-issued photo identification card
- Valid United States Passport
- Government-issued photo identification card
- Valid Virginia college or university student photo identification card
- Valid Employee photo identification card
- New Virginia Voter Photo Identification Card

Most voters already have one of the above listed forms of photo identification. For those that do not have an acceptable form of photo identification, you may obtain a free Virginia Voter Photo Identification Card through any local Voter Registration Office.

Bedford County's Office of Elections will be offering several opportunities to obtain your free Virginia Photo Identification Card in your local community. The following voter photo ID events have been scheduled throughout the County:
