**REFERENCE: PRE-BID MEETING SUMMARY, ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS AND OTHER CLARIFICATIONS**

THIS ADDENDUM SHALL BE ADDED TO AND BECOME A PART OF THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS AND MODIFIES THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS ONLY TO THE EXTENT OF AND IN THE PARTICULARS AS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH, BUT IN NO OTHERS.

This addendum addresses all questions received by deadline of question submission. In addition, it contains clarifications as well as the attendee list.

Pre-Bid Meeting Notes

1. Front End and Schedule was reviewed. This is all found in the Project Manual.
2. Work shall maintain access to buildings and facilities. It is understood that there will be limited times that may require access to be prevented to the storage building or other facilities. This is permissible with coordination in advance with the County.
3. Concept of construction process and requirements were discussed. This is found in the Project Manual and Drawings.
4. This is a County project, therefore, appropriate permits are required, but the fees for County permits will be waived.
5. Dump fees at the County landfill will be waived. Contractor must coordinate between County and trash hauler to make sure the scale house is informed.
6. Time to substantial completion is to be filled in on the bid sheet by the bidder. County's hope and preference is to complete the paving before plants shut down this year.
7. For scheduling purposes. Letter of intent to proceed with contract ready to be signed is anticipated to be issued on October 29 following the October 28 board meeting.

QUESTION AND ANSWERS: Questions are in Bold, Answers are in Italics

**Q. How many calendar days from award of contract to completion?**

*A. The time to substantial completion is to be determined by the bidder and included on the bid form. The county prefers to have paving activities complete before the plants shutdown for winter.*

**Q. Does cold weather days count on project and wet weather days?**

*A. The average amount of cold weather days and wet weather days from the last three years*

shall be incorporated in the construction schedule. Request for weather days exceeding this will be considered by the County.

**Q. Need specs on lighting?**

A. The Falling Creek Park lighting fixture schedule is included in Attachment 3 on Sheet E6.10. Light fixtures for the County Gym are noted in Section "Summary – 01 1000", paragraph 1.3.B(3).

**Q. If Addendum not available til Friday; hard to get quotes by October 2nd.**

A. The County is extending the bid due date to October 9.

**Q. Is stakeout for paving & lighting provided by County?**

A. No, this should be included in the base bid.

**Q. Is paving contractor responsible for striping?**

A. Yes
